The idea was to create a venue for inspirational new groups .to play records otherwise unheard due to a lazy national radio network and to support live entertainment by other media. To a large extent it's ideals were fulfilled, at a time when London was glorifying cocktails and salsa the Soul Kitchen (no. It's not sarcastic! ... all great music is SOULFULL) was delighting to the strains of Fire Engines, Jazzateers, New Orders and Aztec Cameras; "Severance" by Mark Lucas, Young Love by Derek Ridgers , slide shows and great dance. The Soul Kitchen opened up three new venues in town inspired other independent promoter

and fresh discos as well as showing new groups how to cut out rip off promoters by promoting their own events. However, never really seeing themselves as more that instigators and catalysts . 
Put down your pills and stop dreaming about it Pick up your feet and SHOUT about it






